Dee will share the details of the new registry and answer questions about what is going on with organ donation in America. More than 100,000 people in America are waiting for donation of an organ and thousands more are waiting for tissue donation.

Robin O'Donnell shared that Riley bowled a 233 in competition. She also said that she had a fabulous time at the I Drive club. It's a great way to do a makeup.

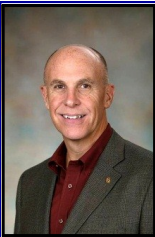
Chad's been way a while, but he's glad to be back and getting involved with Taste.
